◆ Back Lot Art Gallery (308 S. Park Street)

Features local and national emerging artists featuring new artists every few months. Open Friday-Saturday noon-7pm & Sunday 11-4.

◆ Downtown Art Gallery (113 W. Alamo Street)

This gallery houses art for over 50 local and area artists. The collection includes paintings, sculptures, photography, and wood art. Open Monday-Saturday 11-5 & Sunday 11-4.

◆ Tegg Art Studio (119 W. Alamo Street)

Texas landscapes in Oil painted by local, Alicia Tegg. Open Tuesday-Saturday 10-4.

◆ Gerson Artworks (307 W. Alamo Street)

Handmade creations, from the absurd to the profound. Open daily, except when closed.

◆ Bluebonnet Pottery (12341 LBJ Drive, Somerville)
